- **Students earn 5 credits for each class passed with a semester grade of A, B, C or D.**
(These grades meet the Modesto City School (MCS) graduation requirements)
- **To earn a diploma of graduation from Davis High School students must:**
 1. Pass a minimum of 230 credits.
 2. Pass required core courses.

90% - 100%	(Excellent) = A	5 credits	Meet MCS	Meet A-G

(GPA (Grade Point Average) is based on a 4 point scale) A = 4 pts., B = 3 pts., C = 2 pts., D = 1 pt., F = 0 pts.				

**Semester "D" grades DO NOT meet 4 year college/university entrance requirements (A-G). These classes need to be remediated and earn a grade of C or better. Always check with your counselor.
